## Application and use

- // Oust EXTRA is a dispersible granule that is mixed in water and applied as a spray
- // Controls many annual and perennial grasses and broad-leaf weeds in conifer plantations and non-crop sites
- // It is labeled for use with Douglas Fir and more
- // As a spray – apply using ground equipment or helicopter
- // On impregnated fertilizer – apply using ground equipment or by air (helicopter or fixed-wing aircraft)

## Application tips

- // For best results, apply after weeds have emerged and in the early stages of growth
- // The best results on undesirable hardwoods and vines are obtained with a foliar spray between full leaf expansion in the spring and normal defoliation in the fall
- // Tank-mix with Imazapyr for increased control
